

- Wants a steady supplier that he can get reliable supplies from.


#### Scenario

- She loves connecting with her students and wants to continue to teach in person


# Pain Points · Concerns


#### Scenario



- She wants to feel productive again. After being home for nearly 4 months getting back to work is exciting and a nice change in pace.


## Pain Points · Concerns

- Rachel wants to make sure the face masks are comfortable for her and her team to wear all day long.


#### Scenario
